

SAFEmail MMHS (Military Message Handling Solution) Selected for the UK MoD's Type 45 Destroyers

The British Royal Navy's new class of anti-air warfare Destroyer, the Type 45, is recognized as being the most advanced and powerful ships of its kind due to its state-of-the-art communications, radar, weapons and countermeasure systems.

British Aerospace (BAe) has received orders for up to 8 ships from the U.K. Ministry of Defence (MoD), the first of which - HMS Daring – is due for delivery into service in 2010. On completion of Daring's current sea trials, another 5 will follow; Dauntless and Diamond due for service in 2011, and thereafter the Duncan, Dragon and Defender at six monthly intervals.
